ACCEPTABLE USE OF THE WYVERN COLLEGE ICT SYSTEMS AND INTERNET:

AGREEMENT FOR STUDENTS AND PARENTS

I will read and follow the rules in the Acceptable Use Agreement policy

When I use the College's ICT systems (like computers) and use the internet in College I will:

- Always use Wyvern's ICT systems and the internet responsibly and for educational purposes only
- Only use them when a teacher is present, or with a teacher's permission
- Keep my username and passwords safe and not share these with others
- Keep my private information safe at all times and not give my name, address or telephone number to anyone without the permission of my teacher or parent
- Follow the online PRIDe expectations at all times, including when I am taking part in a live Teams lesson
- Tell a teacher (or sensible adult) immediately if I find any material which might upset, distress or harm me or others
- Report any incidents of cyber-bullying to a trusted adult
- Always log off or shut down a computer when I'm finished working on it

I will not:

- Access any inappropriate websites including: social networking sites, chat rooms and gaming sites unless my teacher has expressly allowed this as part of a learning activity
- Open any attachments in emails, or follow any links in emails, without first checking with a teacher
- Use any inappropriate language when communicating online, including in emails
- Participate in any incidents of cyber-bullying
- Log in to Wyvern's network using someone else's details

If I bring a personal mobile phone into College:

- I will only use it in line with the College's mobile phones policy
- If I am given specific permission to use my phone, I will use it responsibly, and will not access any inappropriate websites or other inappropriate material or use inappropriate language when communicating online

Computers

At Wyvern there are many computers available for students to use - but you need to use them appropriately and correctly.

Important rules

- Students may only use a computer with a teacher's permission (this means during lessons, breaks and after college).
- Wyvern computers may only be used for college-related work.
- Proxy websites must not be used in College by students.
- Students should report faults to a member of staff as soon as they are discovered.
- Students should not play games on College computers without the permission of a teacher.
- Students should not access or use social networking sites in College without the permission of a teacher.

The Internet

- The Internet is available on computers in the college, but it is filtered.
- Students should not attempt to bypass these filters. ^[L]_{SEP} Students must not view or download inappropriate materials on College systems.
- When using the Internet, students should be cautious about giving any Internet site personal information about themselves, unless they have cleared it with a teacher.
- Misuse of the Internet will result in suspension of Internet access.

E-mail

- Students must use their Wyvern email account for all communications with teachers.

- Messages to teachers from other mail accounts will not be answered.
- Misuse of the email system will result in suspension of mail access.
- If students send emails, they must remember that they are sending the message as a member of Wyvern. Under no circumstances should a student send any message that could cause offence to the reader.
- Students should only use their email account for college purposes.

Passwords

- Under no circumstances should students tell anyone their passwords.
- Under no circumstances should students share accounts.
- Misuse of passwords will result in suspension of IT access.
