Dear parents and carers,

I hope you and your families are well. This week, I would like to say well done to Year 10 students who took part in mock careers interviews with local employers and trainers. The visiting interviewers commented on how impressive the students were: smart, polite, articulate and confident. I was very proud of them for the planning and preparation they put into this event and of them overcoming their nerves. I would also like to say well done to Year 11 students who have started their GCSE exams with the modern foreign languages speaking exams. I know this is perhaps the exam that they fear the most because they are put on the spot and cannot go back to earlier questions like written exams. This week, students have also had a fun house assembly with more silly games that generate fun and laughter. Students have also had an additional, virtual assembly on vapes, nicotine, THC and spice in the last fortnight.

The government and Ofsted are talking a lot about schools needing to foster a "sense of belonging" for students. A sense of belonging in school refers to every child feeling accepted, valued, and included within their school community. It means students feel safe to be themselves, know that their voices matter, and believe that they are a meaningful part of school life—both in the classroom and beyond. This has become a national focus for schools because research consistently shows that when children feel they belong, they are more likely to engage positively with learning, attend regularly, build strong relationships, and achieve better outcomes. In contrast, a lack of belonging can impact wellbeing, confidence, and academic progress. Schools are therefore prioritising inclusive environments, strong relationships, and pupil voice to ensure that every child feels connected, supported, and able to thrive.

At Wyvern, our trustees (governor) will be coming into college next week to talk to students about this issue and identifying from their discussions, the areas they would like school leaders to focus on next to further develop students sense of belonging at Wyvern. We know that staff-student relationships, extra-curricular activities, praise, rewards, recognition of achievements, involvement in decision making, being able to make a positive contribution and feeling accepted by peers are all important parts of this. It will be interesting to see what students tell us!

### Safeguarding: Doxing

Doxing is defined as "the action or process of searching for and publishing private or identifying information about a particular individual on the internet, typically with malicious intent." What students sometimes struggle

to understand is that all their online activity, from posting video clips to dropping a soundtrack on a Spotify account will remain forever.

This leaves a vulnerability gap that will never close, as the internet is littered with individuals who will look to do harm to the person that has posted content online. It could be for financial gain or just because they feel like it; online viewers can easily find out key details about a person's life from their place of work, the home address, and their identity. People may dox to target an individual because of a disagreement or a conflict they may have had. There could be a desire to intimidate or harass someone which can lead to blackmail or other forms of extortion.

In some cases, doxing is associated with online vigilantism, where individuals take matters into their own hands to expose individuals for a perceived crime or a social injustice. If there is malicious intent, a perpetrator may encourage other online users to harass or abuse the individual also. This can lead to real harm such as stalking, violence or even danger to life. Exposure of personal information can also lead to long-term emotional distress for the victim as well as potential reputational damage. While doxing is not illegal in the UK, it can lead to consequences for the perpetrator if there is malicious intent that leads to harassment of an individual.



We are celebrating Wyvern being located on the Fair Oak site for 60 years. We would like to create a permanent display to mark this important milestone in our history.

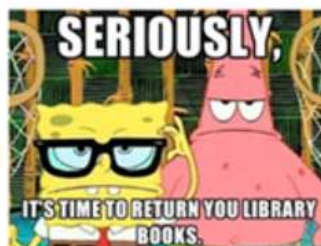

### “BASICS” ASSEMBLY FOLLOW UP

- **Body Clock** - Getting enough sleep, 9-11 hours for an 11-12 year old
- **Activity** - Exercise breaks and fresh air
- **Social Communication** - Face-to-face conversations with peers to develop communication and social skills
- **Intake** - Making sure they have breakfast, less caffeine and water for hydration
- **Control** - You can only control certain things, don't stress about those you can't
- **Support** - Look to friends, teachers and family for support when things get difficult

If you could discuss these at home, we would be greatly appreciative, the more we talk about it the easier it will seem.

Please could I also ask you to check that your child is fully prepared for school, with full equipment ready for every lesson.
