Message from the Headteacher

Dear Parents and Carers.

Options evening

I was delighted to see so many year 8 parents and students at the annual Options' evening this week and to also see so many of the year 9-11 students volunteering to help out by sharing with parents and students about the courses they are taking. We are fortunate to have a talented set of staff which means we can offer over 20 different optional subjects, including academic, technical, practical and vocational courses. Our three-year Key Stage 4 (yrs9-11) means that students get to start the courses earlier than in most schools and specialise in those subjects they care most about.

Another advantage of this model is that year 11 students get to finish the courses earlier than in other schools and so they can begin their revision earlier in their final year. Year 11 students have just completed their second set of trial exams and have been working really hard in preparation for their GCSEs this summer.

Attendance

As we continue to encourage excellent attendance at college, we have launched our first half termly attendance challenge with the students: 100% attendance from 26th February to 28th March will, receive an Easter egg reward. It is open to all students regardless of previous attendance. The new approach is not just about rewards but also raising awareness of the importance of attendance for academic success and personal development.

Interestingly, for the three half terms so far this year, Wyvern attendance is significantly above the national average at the start and end of each half term but dips in the middle to below the national average, but overall Wyvern attendance remains above the national average.

Thank you for your continued efforts in supporting your child's strong attendance.
