1) Create a set of flash cards or use the key word list given in class and available on the revision website below. Spend time learning the words and their meanings. Get other people to test you. Teaching someone else a topic is a good way to cement information in your long-term memory.



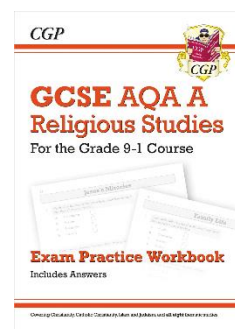
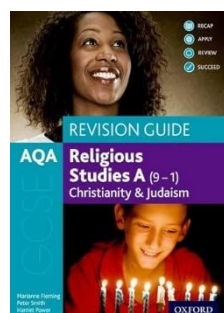
2) Make use of the RE revision website <https://wyvernrevisionre.wordpress.com/> to go over topics you are unsure about.



3) Purchase a copy of the revision guide (available from Amazon). The practice exam booklet is also worth looking at as it provides lots of exam practice and model answers.

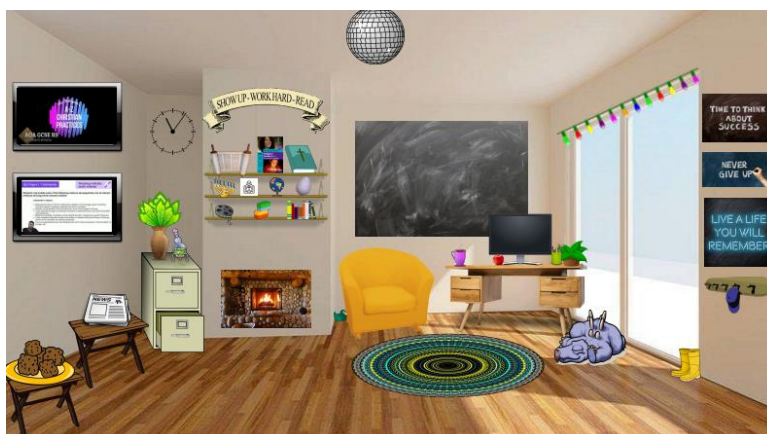
