

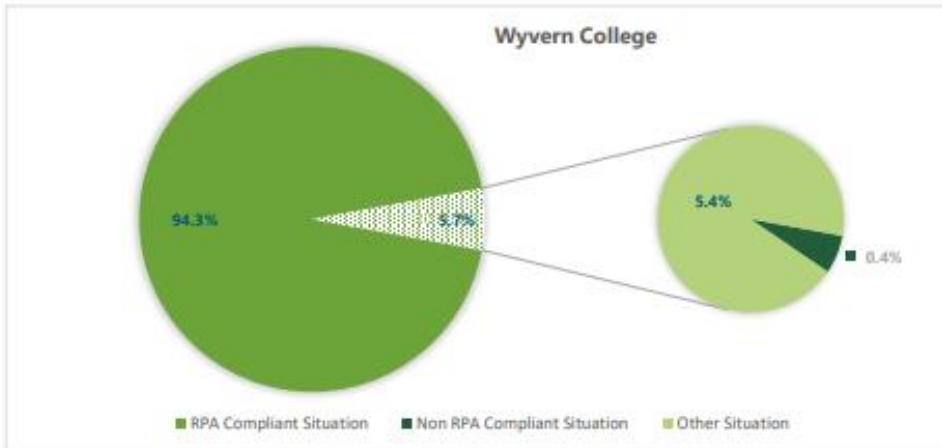

The chart below shows that 94.3% of Wyvern College Year 11s in 2022 moved to participating situations that meet the DfE defined 'Raising the Participation Age (RPA)'. Of the remaining 5.7%, 0.4% moved to Non RPA situations and 5.4% to Other situations. The 'Other' category includes young people who are re-engaging and working towards participation, on a temporary break, unable to engage due to personal reasons as well as those whose situation is unknown or who have moved out of the area.



The same chart showing the total Hampshire cohort indicates that 92.3% of Hampshire Year 11 leavers moved to RPA situations in 2022. The RPA percentage for Wyvern College is higher than that for Hampshire.
