## SOCIAL WORK AND CARE

### Youth worker

Lead activities and offer guidance to young people aged 11 to 25

### Care worker

Help vulnerable people become more independent by supporting them with daily activities

### Social worker

Support vulnerable people to live independent lives, safe from harm or abuse

### Substance misuse practitioner

Support people with drug and alcohol problems

## NURSING

### Nurse

Care for and support patients who are sick, injured, or who have disabilities

### Mental health nurse

Care for and support patients with mental health issues

### Midwife

Care for and support pregnant women and people before, during, and after childbirth

## ALLIED HEALTH

### Occupational therapist

Help people overcome daily struggles caused by health problems, disabilities, accidents, or ageing

### Healthcare support worker

Care for patients in their own homes or in hospitals

### Health awareness specialist

Teach people about health issues

## EMERGENCY CARE

### Paramedic

Give people life-saving medical help in an emergency

### Emergency care assistant

Drive ambulances under emergency conditions and support paramedics


### Emergency medical dispatcher
