

Permission to read from the Upper School library collection (T+ books).

Our library resources are placed in either the Lower School collection for younger teen readers (years 7 & 8) or the Upper School collection for older teens (years 9, 10 and 11) depending on suitability and content.

T+ books are recommended for students in year 9 onward. They may often contain more mature themes relating to relationships or sexual content, swearing or violence, underage drinking / drug use or mental health / social issues.

Students have access to view the whole library collection - via EduLink - so will be able to see if a book they want to read is marked as 13+ and possible trigger words for why in the subject listings. Please have a discussion with your child about what they enjoy reading.

If you would like to give your child access to borrow from the 13+ collection when they are in year 7 or 8 then you will need to give them permission via EduLink.

If you have any caveats such as limiting permission to just one Author, or Series, or to read from just the Manga collection then please send us an email library@wyvern.hants.sch.uk with the details.

Students will not be able to change permissions on their EduLink account. Parents/guardians will need to do so via their EduLink account, and by clicking on their child's account profile picture.

Permissions are found under 'more' and 'update information' as shown below – it may look slightly different using the App but wording in the same.
