Why should I consider studying a T Level?

T Levels are a new qualification that focus on high-level technical study and work-ready skills. They have been developed to offer an alternative to A Levels, but still provide the same number of UCAS points as undertaking three A Levels and will provide you with a clear route to skilled employment, as well as progression to higher or degree Apprenticeships, or degree-level study at university.

T Levels combine the career focus and practical elements of current technical and professional qualifications like BTECs and NVQs, with the theory and study of traditional A Levels.

However, the main difference between T Levels and A Levels is that the core component of the T Level qualification is an industry-based placement, where students will apply the theory they learn in the classroom to the workplace and develop the essential work-ready skills that employers are looking for.



Facts about T Levels:

- Two-year qualification
- 80% time spent in classroom, 20% spent on placement (45 days)
- One T Level is the equivalent of three A Levels and is worth the same amount of UCAS points
- Equipping you with the knowledge and skills employers want

Which T Level should I pick?

If you are in Year 11, you can apply for a variety of T Levels to start with us from September 2021.
